2 Kings 3:9-24

#### ICE BREAKER

What is the first thing you notice when you meet someone new?

#### **GOING DEEPER**

- 1) Read 2 Kings 3:9-24. King Jehoshaphat never asked God if he should align himself with King Jehoram and as a result ended up in a very bad situation. Describe a time when you found yourself in a fix because of a sin, an impulsive decision, or a mistake.
- 2) Read 2 Kings 3:11. What was the first thing Jehoshaphat did when he realized he had put himself in a terrible situation? What can we learn from this?
- 3) When you find yourself in a fix, it's important to humble yourself and seek godly counsel. Why do you think some people are resistant to seeking godly counsel when they find themselves in a bad situation?
- 4) The prophet gave instructions that seemed downright silly, but if victory was to come then obedience was essential. Have you ever had a moment when God told you to do something that seemed unusual? What was the outcome?
- 5) The ditch you dig today is going to hold the blessing of God tomorrow. What has God told you to do that you must carry out in faithfulness and obedience? (Read Galatians 6:9 for encouragement.)

*Galatians 6:9 (GNB)* - So let us not become tired of doing good; for if we do not give up, the time will come when we will reap the harvest.
