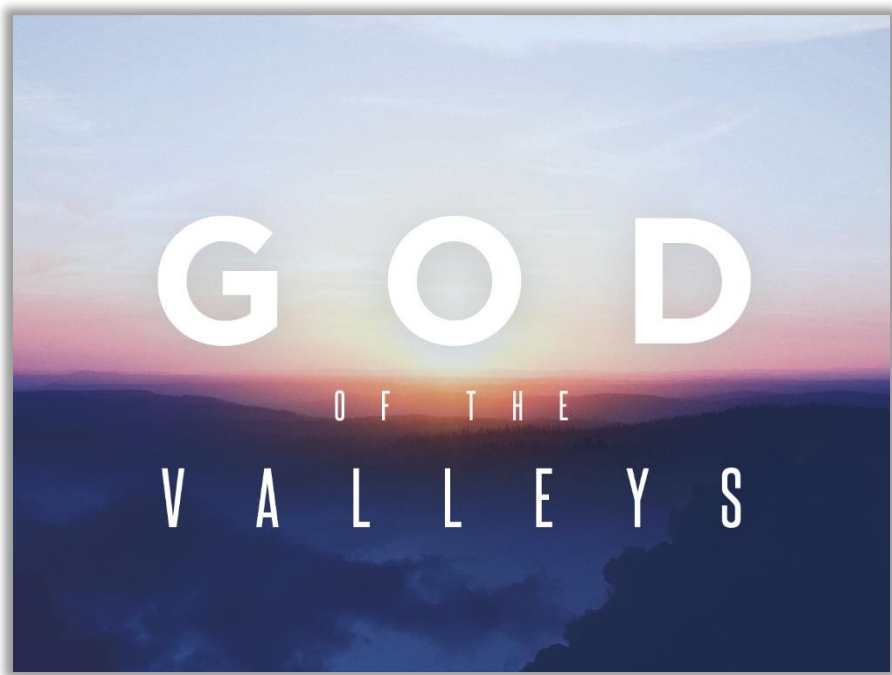

- 3) When you feel you're under attack, do you tend to stop and wait upon the Lord or do you tend to rush ahead of God?
- 4) When the Philistines attacked a second time, David inquired of the Lord again (2 Samuel 5:22-23). Why is it so important to seek the Lord every time we face the attack of the enemy?
- 5) David waited for God to move before he entered the second battle (verse 24). What lesson can we learn from this?
