GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Psalm 69:30-31 and Psalm 100:4. What can we learn about gratitude from these verses?

- 2) Read Acts 16:25-26. Paul and Silas expressed their gratitude to God through praise in spite of horrific circumstances. In what ways do you allow your circumstances to affect your expression of gratitude to God through praise?

- 3) Read 1 Thessalonians 5:15-18 and Colossians 3:17. When are we supposed to be thankful? What is the difference between giving thanks for all circumstances and giving thanks in all circumstances?

- 4) Read Luke 6:45. What does complaining reveal about us? What does gratitude reveal about us?

- 5) How is complaining a symptom of ingratitude?
