Hebrews 10:1-18; 1 John 1:9

ICE BREAKER

If you could choose your age forever, what age would you choose and why?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Hebrews 10:12. Why is it significant that Jesus "sat down at the right hand of God" after he had offered himself as a sacrifice for sins?
- 2) Hebrews 10:18 teaches us that there is no longer any need for sacrifice for our sin after we have received forgiveness from Jesus. Why is that a struggle for those of us who are "rule followers"?
- 3) Pastor Dave said, "The sacrifice is done, the price is already paid, and now all He asks as that we be honest with Him about the junk in our hearts [1 John 1:9]." How does that make you feel?
- 4) Pastor Dave said, "You'll never know the fullness of Jesus until you understand that you don't bring an offering to His altar, you lay down on it." What struggles have you faced as you have tried to lay yourself on the altar?
- 5) Have you been offering your religious activities to God instead of getting on the altar yourself? What needs to change in your life?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Hebrews 10:12-14 (NLT) - But our High Priest offered himself to God as a single sacrifice for sins, good for all time. Then he sat down in the place of honor at God's right hand. There he waits until his enemies are humbled and made a footstool under his feet. For by that one offering he forever made perfect those who are being made holy.
