	OING DEEPER Read Acts 8:5-8, 26-40. What does God call Philip to do following the revival in Samaria? Why might this call be unexpected?
2)	God calls Philip to go to a desert place. What was Philip's immediate response? (Hint: Look at verse 27.)
3)	Pastor Dave said, "Sometimes a desert doesn't just happen to us, but it is God's explicit will for the immediate moment." What are some reasons why God might lead us into a desert experience?
4)	What does it say about a person's faith in God if he or she can only say that they are in God's hand when things are great and life is comfortable?
5)	Why do you think the miracles that God does in our lives don't always look like the miracle we expected?
