GOING DEEPER

- 4) Did you learn to pray as a child? If so, how did you learn? How can we teach the children of our church to pray?
- 5) How can we invest in the lives of children to help them fulfill God's plan for their lives? How can you, as an individual, make a difference in the life of a child?
