1.	Read Luke 14:25-33. Jesus said to count the cost of following him.
	What has following Jesus cost you? Is there anything you haven't
	been willing to surrender to him? (Try to be as honest with
	yourself as possible.)

2. Why do you think that people are willing to sacrifice for monetary gain or political freedom, but they struggle sacrificing for spiritual gain?

3. Read Matthew 11:29-30. If a person is yoked with Jesus, that means Jesus can control where they go and what they do. Are there areas of your life that are not under Jesus' control?

4. Are you active in the Great Commission or are you making excuses?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Luke 14:26–27 (NLT) - If you want to be my disciple, you must hate everyone else by comparison—your father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even your own life. Otherwise, you cannot be my disciple. And if you do not carry your own cross and follow me, you cannot be my disciple.
