GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Exodus 34:6, Psalm 31:19, Psalm 34:8, Psalm 86:5, Psalm 145:9, Nahum 1:7, and Lamentations 3:25. What character trait of God do these passages talk about?
- 2) Read Job 9:4-10, 1 Chronicles 29:11, Jeremiah 10:12, Isaiah 40:25-26, and Matthew 19:26. What character trait of God do these passages point out?
- 3) Why is free will so important to the concept of love?
- 4) Read James 1:13-15. What does this passage tell us about the source of evil in our lives?
- 5) Read Romans 8:28. What does this verse say about how God's love and His power come together in our everyday lives?
- 6) How is waiting on God related to trusting Him? Do you think the two can really be separated?
