GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Deuteronomy 9:13 and Exodus 33:3. Why is stubbornness spiritually dangerous for us?
- 2) Read Luke 22:42. What model did Jesus give us in regard to dealing with our own willfulness? How difficult do you find it to follow Jesus' example in this area?
- 3) Read 1 Peter 5:5-6. Why is pride spiritually dangerous for us? How is disobedience an outgrowth of pride in our lives?
- 4) Read Isaiah 6:1-5. How did Isaiah react when he came face to face with the holiness and majesty of God? What effect does getting a glimpse of God's holiness affect us?
- 5) Do you tend to respond with anger or with compassion to all of the wickedness around us? How do you think you would change if you could see the world the way God sees it?
- 6) Read John 9:4. What does that verse mean for us today and what response does it stir up within you?
