GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Exodus 3:1-4. Why do you think it was significant that the first thing God said at the burning bush was Moses' name?
- 2) Read Exodus 3:11, 4:1, 4:10, & 4:13. How is Moses different after 40 years in the desert than he was when he killed the Egyptian?
- 3) Pastor Dave said, "As long as you have confidence in yourself you will never find freedom from your brokenness and pain because you will never really turn to God." What do you think about that statement?
- 4) How does knowing Moses' story help encourage us to never give up?
- 5) Are you going through a desert experience right now? What do you think God is trying to accomplish in your life while you're there?
