- 3) Pastor Dave said that children learn primarily by example. What are the implications of this statement for parents as they teach their children about Jesus?
- 4) What's the difference between perfection and being consistent? Where do you need to grow to be more consistent in your faith?
- 5) There are many people who need the guidance of a mature, seasoned follower of Christ – they need a spiritual mother (or father). Do you know of anyone whom you could serve as a spiritual parent to help them grow?
