ICE BREAKER

If you had unlimited power for a day, what would you do?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Acts 2:1-16. Can you remember why these specific signs (wind, fire, speaking in tongues) would have been significant to these Jewish believers in the upper room?
- 2) Read Acts 1:8. Jesus told the disciples that they would receive power when the Holy Spirit came upon them. For what did the Holy Spirit enable them and why did they need it?
- 3) Do believers today still need the power of the Holy Spirit in their lives? What are the consequences (individually and corporately) of not receiving the power of the Holy Spirit?
- 4) Why is desperation for Jesus an important component if a person is seeking the baptism in the Holy Spirit?
- 5) Read Ephesians 5:18. How can a person cultivate the habit of dependency on the Holy Spirit in his or her daily life?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Acts 2:1–16 (NIV) - When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.
