GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Exodus 3:1-14 and 4:1-17. What were some of Moses' excuses that he tried to use to get out of what God was calling him to do?
- 2) How is making excuses about why we can't be used of God really a lack of faith?
- 3) Have you ever made an excuse when you sensed God telling you He wanted to use you to do something? What was the situation and how did it play out?
- 4) Have you ever resisted God's voice because you were afraid you wouldn't know the answers that someone might ask? How should you have handled the situation?
- 5) Pastor Dave said that the words "what if" are the words of worriers. Has worry ever kept you from obeying God? How did you handle it?
- 6) God didn't give up on Moses when he made some bad choices. He still had a plan for him. Have you ever felt that you couldn't be used by God because you have blown it in the past? What do you think God's message is to you in light of how He treated Moses?
