GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Exodus 2:11-12 and Acts 7:22-24. How do these verses show Moses acting in anger? Why did he do what he did?
- 2) Read Exodus 11:1-9. In light of verse 1, should Moses have been surprised when Pharaoh didn't listen? Why was Moses angry?
- 3) Read Exodus 32:15-19. How did Moses let his anger show in this passage? Did God ever approve of Moses' anger?
- 4) Read Numbers 20:1-12. How did Moses' anger lead him to disobey God in this passage? What were the consequences?
- 5) Anger is not a sin; what we do in response to our anger can be righteous or unrighteous. What are some examples of each response?
- 6) How has your response to your own anger affected other people's view of God? Is there anything you need to do to repair any issues your anger may have caused?
- 7) Read 1 Corinthians 10:13. What does this verse mean for us when we're tempted to sin in anger?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

1 Corinthians 10:13 (ESV) - No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.
