GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Isaiah 61:1-9. What are some of the things this passage of Scripture promises the Messiah would do? How do those promises apply to your life?
- 2) What does it mean to put on the garment of praise? How do you think it affects a person when they begin to praise God in spite of their troubles and sorrows?
- 3) In Isaiah 61:4, God promises Israel that He will help them rebuild what had been destroyed. What areas of your life seemed to be hopelessly destroyed, but Jesus has begun to rebuild and renew what you thought was lost forever?
- 4) Isaiah 61:7 says that God will give His people a double portion of His inheritance along with everlasting joy in place of their shame. How had God replaced shame with joy in your life?
- 5) Read Isaiah 61:8, Jeremiah 31:3-4, and Romans 8:38-39. What do these verses tell us about how long God's love for us will last? Does this love depend on our behavior or on God's character in order to be lasting? What does the answer to that question mean to us in our daily lives?

Jeremiah 31:3–4 (NIV) - The LORD appeared to us in the past, saying: “I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with loving-kindness. I will build you up again and you will be rebuilt.”
