- 3) How does allowing your focus to be on other human beings affect your ability to worship God?

- 5) Pastor Dave said, "Worshiping God and working for God go hand-in-hand." What do you think that statement means? Is it possible to worship God without working for Him?
- 6) What steps can you take personally to develop and nurture a lifestyle of worship?
