Acts 27:9–28:10; Daniel 4:30–37

ICE BREAKER

What would you do if you had a million dollars?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Acts 27:9-28:10. When the storm got really bad, the crew began to throw cargo overboard. Does God sometimes allow storms in our lives that cause us to reevaluate what really matters in life? What really matters in life to you?
- 2) How did Paul's presence on the ship affect the safety of the other passengers and crew? How does God use the storms in our lives to bless other people around us?
- 3) Pastor Dave said that sometimes God allows our lives to be shipwrecked in order to get our attention. Read Daniel 4:30-37 and talk about how this story backs that up.
- 4) After reaching the shore safely, Paul is suddenly bitten by a deadly snake. What was Paul's reaction to this horrifying event? How did the islanders react to it? How did God use this snakebite to glorify His name? What does that teach us about the problems we face in life?
