# GROWING IN THE STORM

*John 16:1-7, 12-16, 31-33; Romans 8:28, 14:11; Matthew 26:33; Hebrews 12:11; 1 Peter 5:5-6; Isaiah 45:23; Philippians 2:10-11*

## ICE BREAKER

What is worst storm you've ever experienced?

## GOING DEEPER

- 1) In John 16:1-5, Jesus tells the disciples that “storms” are heading their way. How is it encouraging for us to know that Jesus already knows about a storm before it hits in our lives?
- 2) Read Romans 8:28. What does this verse tell us about what God will do in us during the storms of life?
- 3) In John 16:12-16, Jesus tells the disciples that there are things he wants to tell them, but they're not ready for it. In other words, Jesus gave them enough light for the moment, but would reveal more later. Why is it important for us to know that Jesus only gives us the light we need in the moment?
- 4) How can a storm show us what we really not, not what we think we are?
- 5) Read Hebrews 12:11. How can a storm help bring spiritual growth in us?
- 6) Why is settling the lordship issue in our lives the key to dealing with the storms we face in life?
- 7) Read 1 Peter 5:5-6. Why is humbling ourselves so important if we want to learn from God during the storms of life?

*Hebrews 12:11 (NIV)* - No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.
