John 3:17, 4:5-41, 14:6; Galatians 3:28

ICE BREAKER

If you are at a friend or relative's house for dinner and you find a dead insect in your salad, what would you do?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read John 4:5-41. The Jewish people of Jesus' day despised the Samaritans, hated them, and treated them like scum. How did Jesus treat the Samaritan woman at the well? What can we learn about how to treat people around us from the way Jesus treated this Samaritan woman?
- 2) Look at John 4:10-18 again. In this passage, Jesus exposes this woman's immoral lifestyle. What attitudes did Jesus display when confronting the sin in this woman's life? What can we learn from His example?
- 3) After being confronted with her sin, the Samaritan woman began to talk about the difference between what the Jews believed and what the Samaritans believed. It would have been really easy for Jesus to get caught up in a religious argument, but He didn't. What can we learn from Jesus about dealing with people who want to argue with us when we try to share the gospel with them?
- 4) Have you ever been tempted to value winning arguments more than winning souls?
- 5) Read John 4:35. In what ways is this verse still applicable to us today?

John 4:35 (NIV) - Do you not say, "Four months more and then the harvest"? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest.
