2 Chronicles 20:1-24

ICE BREAKER

What would you do in life if you knew you could not fail?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read 2 Chronicles 20:1-12. What was the problem confronting King Jehoshaphat and the nation of Israel? What chance did they have to win the impending battle? Have you ever faced an unwinnable battle?
- 2) Read 2 Chronicles 20:7-9. Upon what did King Jehoshaphat focus in his prayer? Did he focus on the problem or on God's past faithfulness? When you're faced with a problem, do you tend to focus on God's faithfulness or on the problem at hand?
- 3) Read 2 Chronicles 20:15-17. What was God's response to King Jehoshaphat's prayer? What did God promise to do for Israel? What might we be able to learn from this?
- 4) Read 2 Chronicles 20:22-24. What was the final outcome of the battle? How was the battle won? What can we learn about our own battles from this?
- 5) If you find yourself in a battle, the best thing to do is remember God's faithfulness and His power. What are some specific ways in which God has shown His faithfulness to you over the years?
- 6) What are some things for which you can praise God, even if your circumstances appear to be bleak?

2 Chronicles 20:15-17 (NLT) - He said, "Listen, all you people of Judah and Jerusalem! Listen, King Jehoshaphat! This is what the LORD says: Do not be afraid! Don't be discouraged by this mighty army, for the battle is not yours, but God's."
