GOING DEEPER

- 1) What's the difference between universal promises of God and personal promises of God? Can you think of an example of each? Why does it matter?

- 2) Read 2 Corinthians 1:20. What does this verse have to say about God's reliability when it comes to His promises?

- 3) Read Psalm 145:15 and Genesis 21:2. What's the difference between proper time (or appointed time) and preferred time? How have you experienced receiving God's blessings at the proper time as opposed to your preferred time?

- 4) Pastor Dave said, "God has a plan for our lives, and He knows when it is the right time to fulfill His promises in our lives." Why is that important for us to remember?

- 5) Why is it important for us to make a point to remember all the great things God has done for His people and for us individually? What happens to us if we lose sight of that?
