GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Judges 6:1-6. What were the circumstances Israel was enduring and why were they suffering? Are there any lessons we can learn from this?
- 2) Read Judges 6:11-12. Where was Gideon when the angel of the Lord spoke to him and why was he there? Why is it surprising that the angel called Gideon a mighty warrior?
- 3) Pastor Dave said that when God called Gideon a mighty warrior, he was speaking to his future, not to his past. What does that say about how the Lord may speak to you?
- 4) What can we learn from Gideon about asking God questions when He asks us to do something that requires a huge step of faith?
- 5) Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-29. What can we learn about how God chooses the people He wants to use? What does it say about the fact that God chose you?
