GOING DEEPER

- 1) In Jeremiah 20:18, Jeremiah asked, "Why was I ever born?" How do people try to answer that vital question today? Why do the different philosophical methods used to answer that question always come up short?
- 2) According to Proverbs 16:4, why were all things created? What does Ephesians 1:4 tell us about God's motive for creating us?
- 3) Read Psalm 139:1-6, 13-18. What does this tell us about God's love for us? How does knowing that God was intimately involved in creating us and that He loves us deeply help us find significance?
- 4) If you purchase an item and don't know what it's been designed to do, you can either speak to the creator of the item or you can read the user's manual. What does that teach us about finding our purpose in life?
- 5) Read Colossians 1:16. According to the last sentence of that verse, why were you created? What does that mean to you?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Colossians 1:16 (NLT) - Through him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see—such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through him and for him.
