What is the hardest thing you have ever done?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Acts 18:24-26 and Acts 19:1-6. What did Apollos and the disciples in Ephesus have in common? What was the solution for their situation?
- 2) Read 1 Corinthians 8:1. Why is it important to maintain a teachable spirit, even when we have a great deal of knowledge?
- 3) After Paul explained the gospel more fully to the disciples in Ephesus, they were filled with the Holy Spirit. According to Acts 1:8, what happens in our lives when we are filled with the Holy Spirit?
- 4) Pastor Dave said, “Experiencing the fullness of the Spirit is not about a one-time emotional experience; experiencing the fullness of the Spirit is an all-throughout-the-day experience.” What do you think that means and how does that play out in a person’s life?
- 5) Why is it important to remember that the gifts of the Spirit are always used to serve other people and to glorify Jesus?
