ICE BREAKER

What is your favorite part of celebrating Easter?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. Paul describes various areas of sin that keep humanity from inheriting the kingdom of God. What was Paul's point in making this list? How does it relate to us today?
- 2) In 1 Corinthians 6:11, Paul says "And such were some of you." Why is that phrase so important?
- 3) In the last part of verse 11, Paul tells us what happened to those people who had been involved in the sins he listed. What happened to them? Did they clean themselves up?
- 4) Read Ephesians 2:1-7. What was our spiritual condition before Christ and what does He do for those who come to Him in faith for salvation?
- 5) Read Ephesians 2:8-9. How are we saved? Do our works play any part at all? Why has God planned our salvation in this way?
- 6) Read Ephesians 2:10. We are not saved by our works, but we are saved for something. What is God's purpose in saving us?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Ephesians 2:8-10 (ESV) - For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.
