GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Romans 3:10-12, 3:23, 5:12, and Psalm 51:5. What do these verses tell us about sin and the human race?
- 2) There's an old saying that says, "You can't make a cucumber out of a pickle." What does that mean and how does that statement reflect the reality we face as sinners?
- 3) Read Isaiah 64:6. What does this verse say to anyone who believes that they can make it into heaven if they do enough good things?
- 4) Read Romans 7:15, 18. How do these verses reflect the reality of any person trying to become godly in their own strength?
- 5) Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. What does this verse say to us about living a life that is different than we have lived in the past?
- 6) Read Romans 8:5-6 and Romans 12:2. What part does a person's mind play in nurturing the new life given by God and in transforming the way a person lives?
