GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Ephesians 2:8-9 and Titus 3:5. What do these verses have in common? What do they teach us about being saved?
- 2) Why is it important to remember that God's grace and mercy not only saves us, but it's His grace and mercy that sustains us in our daily walk with Christ?
- 3) Read Romans 5:20-6:2. What does this passage tell us about taking God's grace and forgiveness for granted by continuing to live in sin?
- 4) Pastor Dave said, "Sin never makes the situation better." How have you found that statement to be true in your life?
- 5) Read Lamentations 3:22-23. What can we learn about God's love and mercy from this passage? What does that mean for us on a daily basis?
- 6) Why is it so important to realize that lasting change in our lives actually takes place one day at a time?
