GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Hebrews 11:31. What is shocking or surprising about this verse? What message does it convey to us today?

- 2) Rahab was living in the promised land but wasn't living the promised life. Have you ever known someone who claimed to be a Christian but didn't seem to be living in the fruit of the Spirit? How is that like Rahab's experience?

- 3) Pastor Dave said, "Rahab didn't need a new city; she needed a new kingdom." How does that relate to us when we think we need a change of scenery because we're not experiencing the abundant life Jesus promised His followers? Is the problem usually in the outward circumstances or inside of the person?

- 4) Read James 2:26. Rahab's life was changed because of a simple act of faith. How do our actions relate to our faith?

- 5) Pastor Dave gave four earmarks of faith that we see in Rahab's story. What are the four things faith requires?
