ICE BREAKER

If you were to write a book about yourself, what would you name it?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Read Joshua 3:1-16. How is this story similar to the story of the Israelites at the Red Sea? What does this tell us about God's ability to perform miracles more than once?
- 2) When faced with the obstacle of the Jordan River, the Israelites waited for three days before they made a move. Why is it important to wait on God and listen for His direction when you're faced with a problem or an obstacle?
- 3) How do obstacles provide us an opportunity to evaluate what's going on in our lives?
- 4) Read Joshua 3:8, 13, 15-6. Did the water stop flowing before the priests who were carrying the Ark of the Covenant entered the river or after? What are the implications for us when we face obstacles?
- 5) Read James 4:8. Who moves first in this verse? What does that tell us about taking the steps that we can take and leaving the rest to God?
- 6) How do our obstacles provide God an opportunity to put His grace and power on display?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Joshua 3:15-16 (NLT) - It was the harvest season, and the Jordan was overflowing its banks. But as soon as the feet of the priests who were carrying the Ark touched the water at the river's edge, the water above that point began backing up a great distance away at a town called Adam, which is near Zarethan. And the water below that point flowed on to the Dead Sea until the riverbed was dry. Then all the people crossed over near the town of Jericho.
