ICE BREAKER

Tell the story of the greatest triumph in your life.

GOING DEEPER

- 1) In what ways did the people of Israel have greater responsibilities in the Promised Land than they had in the desert? Read Luke 12:48. What does this verse tell us about our responsibilities when we have been given much?

- 2) Read Joshua 6:1–21. The Israelites marched around Jericho for seven days, even though it seemed as if their daily activity was accomplishing nothing. What does that teach us about faithfully pursuing God in our daily activities?

- 3) Read Joshua 6:10. What are some reasons that God may have told the Israelites to be quiet while they were marching around Jericho? What can we learn from this?

- 4) Why is it important to avoid constantly talking about our problems? What should we be talking about instead of our problems?

- 5) Read Joshua 6:18. Why is it important for us to deal with the sin in our lives ruthlessly?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Joshua 6:20 (NLT) - When the people heard the sound of the rams' horns, they shouted as loud as they could. Suddenly, the walls of Jericho collapsed, and the Israelites charged straight into the town and captured it.
