Exodus 3:1–8, 11–14, 4:1–5; Matthew 28:19–20; Romans 10:14–15

ICE BREAKER

What is the most daring thing you've ever done in your life?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) What does it mean to embrace the moment when we are living in the in between and waiting on God?
- 2) Read Exodus 3:4. Why is it significant that Moses turned aside to see what was going on at the burning bush? What does this teach us about responding to moments when God is trying to speak to us?
- 3) What do you think Moses might have felt when the first thing he heard from the burning bush was the voice of God calling out his name? What does the fact the God called Moses by name teach us?
- 4) Moses was commanded to throw down his staff. Why was Moses' staff significant to him? Is God speaking to you about letting go of something that you're hanging onto?
- 5) Read Matthew 28:19-20 and Romans 10:14-15. What do these verses tell us about God's plan for the church and for the world? Why is it so important that we learn to align ourselves with God's plan instead of asking God to bless our plans?

GOD'S TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Exodus 3:2–4 (ESV) - And the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush. He looked, and behold, the bush was burning, yet it was not consumed. And Moses said, “I will turn aside to see this great sight, why the bush is not burned.” When the Lord saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him out of the bush, “Moses, Moses!” And he said, “Here I am.”
