JOSHUA AND THE GENERAL

Joshua 5:13–6:5; Genesis 12:2–3; Proverbs 19:21; Romans 8:32

ICE BREAKER

What is the hardest thing you have ever done?

GOING DEEPER

- 1) Why do you think it might have been difficult for Joshua to follow Moses as the leader of the Israelites?
- 2) Read Joshua 5:13-6:5. What clues does this passage give showing that the identity of the Commander of the army of the Lord is actually Jesus appearing before His incarnation?
- 3) Joshua asked if Jesus was on his side; however, Jesus' answer showed that He was not on any human being's side, but on the side of the Lord. In other words, it mattered not whether He was on Joshua's side, but whether Joshua was on the Lord's side. How should that influence the way we pray?
- 4) What is the difference between asking Jesus to be your Savior and surrendering yourself to His lordship? Why does it matter?
- 5) Joshua, a sinful man, was in the presence of Jesus, who is perfectly holy, yet Jesus didn't strike Joshua dead with his sword. How is that a picture of God's grace towards us?
- 6) Joshua and the Israelites obeyed the word of the Lord and He gave them the victory over Jericho that they needed. What lessons can we learn from this?
